Why should I apply?

Sigma Pi Sigma is the physics honors society. Membership adds distinction to your resume, and your name will be registered in the national Sigma Pi Sigma registry.

Do I qualify for membership?

To apply for induction into Sigma Pi Sigma a candidate is expected to have at least a 3.0 GPA and have at least a sophomore level standing in their physics courses. In addition the applicant must demonstrate excellence in at least two of the following categories.

- **Academics:** A minimum 3.5 GPA in their physics major courses
- **Research:** Involved in substantial research (in addition to their senior project work).
- **Outreach:** Consistent participation and/or innovation involving outreach events.
- **SPS:** Consistent participation and involvement in SPS activities.

How do I apply?

Submit a cover letter and your DARS report to Joy Lindell by Thursday, March 12, 2009. On your cover letter

- Give your name
- How many semesters of physics you have had
- Your physics GPA
- Your overall GPA
- Describe any research you have done, any contributions to outreach, and any service to the department.
